




**2013 Rafer Johnson Jr. High  
Baseball TEAM RULES**  
All players will abide by the following team rules:



1. Players are expected to always try to do their best in each practice session and in each game: always striving to improve their skills.
2. Players will always listen to instructions from the coaches and will conduct themselves properly in behavior and language among themselves and towards everybody else.
3. All rules will be strictly followed.
4. Players must wear the official Olympian uniform for all games: Hat, Jersey, Belt, & socks. No player will be allowed to play without the above listed items.
5. No jewelry of any kind is permitted on players.
6. No foul Language of any kind will be permitted.
7. All players that practice will play. If you miss practice without an excuse there will be some penalties in playing time.
8. Equipment is to be used for Baseball only. All players will be responsible for their equipment at all times. Players will never throw equipment.
9. All players must hustle and display good teamwork.
10. During a game all players will remain in the bench area unless playing on the field.
11. During the game or practice no player is allowed to talk to anyone but, their coaches or team members.
12. Do not say anything to members of an opposing team or the umpires during a game.
13. Each player is expected to follow these rules and guidelines, as well as those given by the coach and the school.
14. The Rafer Johnson Jr. High has a "Zero Tolerance" for any/all physical altercations.
